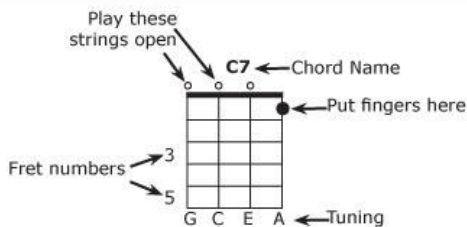


Hello! I've worked up this song chart to hopefully make it easier to play along with our ukulele lesson. First, some tips on how to read a chord diagram: Imagine holding the ukulele in front of you, with the fretboard facing you. Then look at the diagram below; makes sense, right? The vertical lines are the strings, and the horizontal lines are the frets. The dots tell you where to put your finger(s).



Below is the chart for Let It Be. The chord diagrams are placed above the words of the song where they should be played. The chords for one verse, one chorus, and the bridge are shown; the other verses and choruses use the same patterns. Each chord should get 2 beats, except for two chords in the bridge that get 1 beat each. I will represent this in the bridge section of the chart with slashes below the chord diagrams- the slashes mean the number of beats each chord gets. Have fun, and please refer back to video #3 if you need some help!
