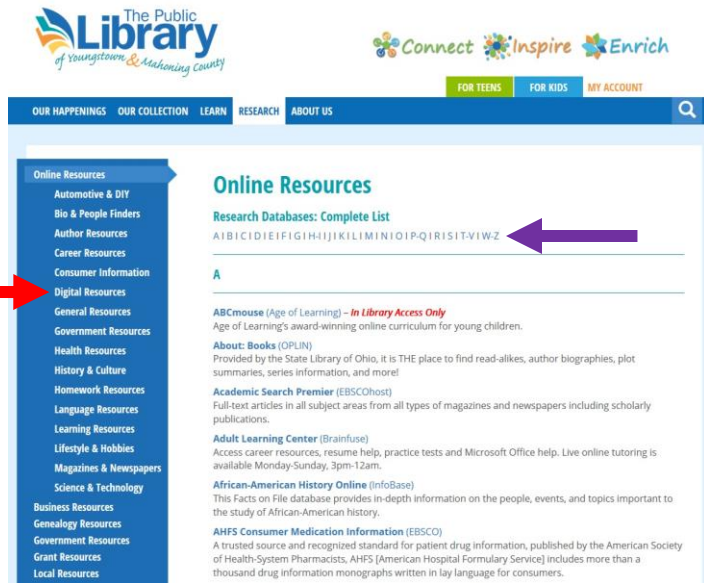

- 1 At the Library's home page, www.LibraryVisit.org, Scroll to **Research**, and Click on **Online Resources**.



- 2 To access Online Resources from outside a library building, click on the name of the resource and proceed to step 3 below.



Library Online Resources are: listed alphabetically, **Click on a Letter** or by subject, **Click on a Topic**.

- 3 If prompted, enter your **ZIP code** or **Library barcode number**. You may also need to select your library, **Public Library of Youngstown and Mahoning County**, from a drop-down menu.
