The American Revolution: Screening, Panel, and Digital Exhibition

The American Revolution, the latest film by Ken Burns, Sarah Botstein, and David Schmidt, examines how America's founding turned the world upside-down. Thirteen British colonies on the Atlantic Coast rose in rebellion, won their independence, and established a new form of government that radically reshaped the continent and inspired centuries of democratic movements around the globe.

In collaboration with PBS Western Reserve, we're hosting a free event featuring a digital exhibition of materials from the American Revolution era, an abbreviated screening of the new Ken Burns film, and a panel discussion led by experts on the subject of women, literature, and the revolution.
