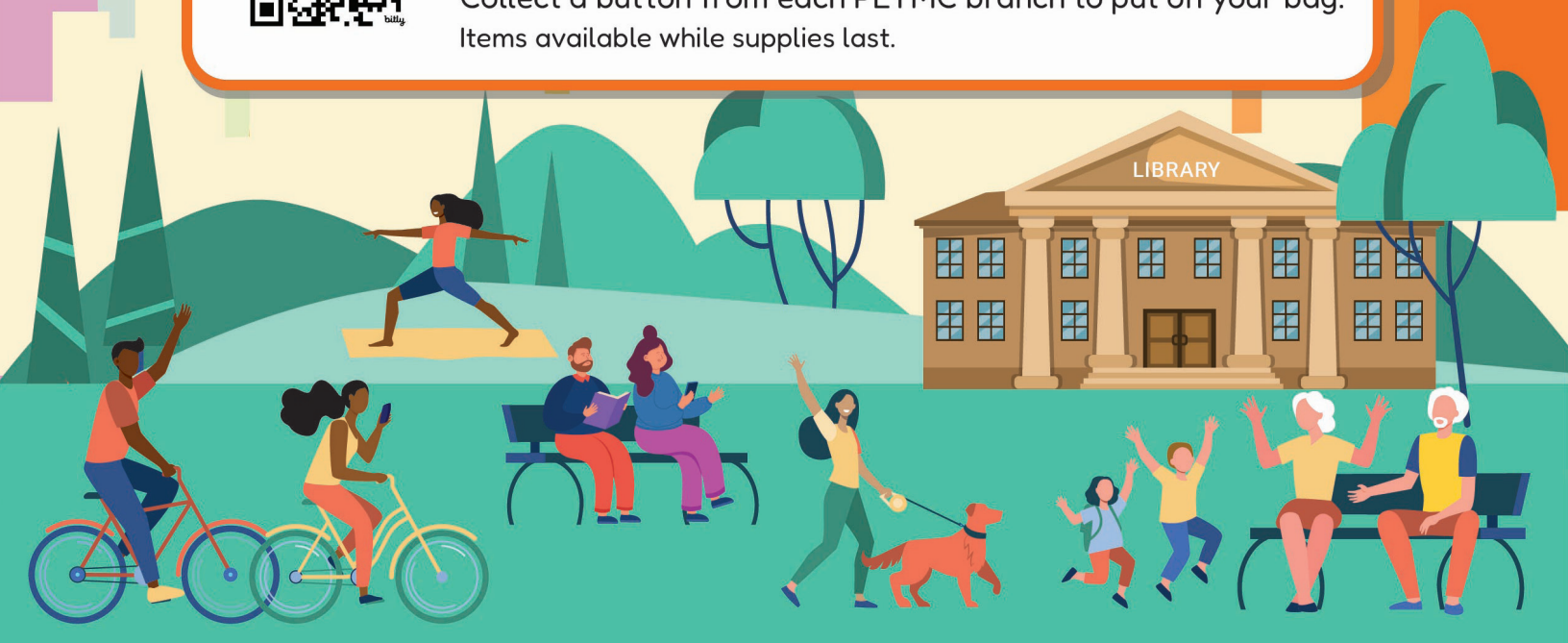
Summer Discovery is a free program for all ages. Track your reading, earn a book prize and attend fun programs all summer long!

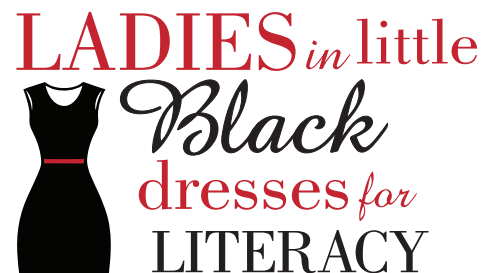

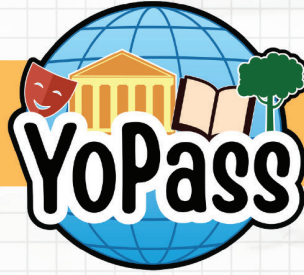

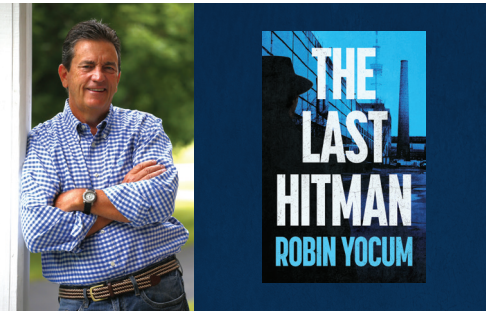
